Awards for Grant-Writing Support

The Center for Economics & Public Policy (CEPP) is offering two awards in support of policy-related grant-writing to UCI faculty, to be awarded in the spring of 2013. Faculty applying for these awards must commit to submit a research proposal to a funder external to the university, to be administered through CEPP. The research can be on any economics-related public-policy topic, and eligibility is *not* restricted to economics faculty. Half the award will be distributed initially, and half when the proposal is submitted. The awards can be one of two types:

1. A \$2,000 award to individual faculty members
2. A \$3,000 award to individual faculty members co-authoring the proposal and subsequent research with a Ph.D. student

The funds may be used for graduate student support, faculty support, or research-related expenses. In the case of a joint faculty-student award, faculty are strongly encouraged to provide some graduate student support. CEPP will provide administrative support for producing and administering the grant.

Proposals should consist of a three-page (double-spaced) project description and a budget for the award. The proposal should identify at least one organization to which the proposal will be submitted, and explain why the proposal is likely to appeal to that organization. (You are encouraged to explore funding interest and provide documentation as part of the proposal.)

Proposals are due to David Neumark (dneumark@uci.edu) by April 30, 2013. Proposals will be selected by the CEPP Internal Advisory Committee, which consists of David Neumark, Marianne Bitler, Kitt Carpenter, David Brownstone, and Greg Duncan.
